FVBPA SMART YOUTH TOURNAMENTS

TOURNAMENT RULES

- All USBC rules and regulations will govern these USBC Certified Tournaments.
- Open to all USBC FVBPA youth bowlers (see doubles & trios for exception) INCLUDING travelers from a FVBPA center.
- Handicap when applied will be 90% of 150 for lower division & 90% of 220 for higher division.
- Coaching will be acceptable during tournaments as long as it is done in a proper manner outside of the bowler's area.
- Averages: Last year's high average (21 game minimum) if current (21 game minimum) is 10 pins higher use current average. If no average last year use current 21+ game average. FVBPA Summer travel may be used if no other average applies based on 21 game minimum. All others bowl scratch (220). Averages must be verified by your Youth Director or Proprietor.
- ENTRY FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY FORMS @ \$30 per bowler per event (you may bowl in all tournaments minus the Best of the Best). Make checks payable to FVBPA.
- Any situation needing attention will be addressed by the tournament committee as well as ALL Scholarship Disbursements.
- All scores posted are unofficial until final standings are announced.
- Scratch Single's Format- 4 divisions 150 & under (Boys & Girls) and 151 & over (Boys & Girls). 3 game series total.
- Doubles Format- 2 divisions any combo 1 FVBPA member must be on a team. 300 combined average & under and 301 combined average & over. 3 game series plus handicap total.
- Trios Format-2 divisions must have 1 girl on the team and 2 of them must be a FVBPA member. 450 combined average & under and 451 combined average and over. 3 game series plus handicap total.
- 8/9 Pin Format - 2 divisions based on mean average lower half bowl 8 pin no tap (8 pins or higher on 1st ball counts as a strike) higher half bowl 9 pin no tap (9 pins or higher on 1st bowl counts as a strike). 3 game series plus handicap total.
- Battle of The Best Format- Top 3 from each event and division. Bowlers will be notified if they advance, and format will be announced by FVBPA board on 12/2/23.
