2017 \$1,000 BUD TRIO CHALLENGE RULES & INFORMATION

- This league is USBC certified. Any bowlers not certified for the 2016-2017 season must pay the certification fee on their first night of bowling.
- A bowler's entering average will be his or her highest verifiable average of 21 games or more from the 2015-2016 or 2016-2017 league season. The entering average will be used to determine handicap for the first 9 games bowled. A bowler with no verifiable average will establish the first night of bowling.
- Handicap will be 90% of 200. A blind (absentee) score will be the bowler's average minus 10 pins. A vacancy score will be 120.
- This is a mixed league with 3-person teams bowling 3 games per week. Teams may consist of any combination of men and women.
- There will be one position round on week 14, the last week of bowling.
- All league fees must be paid in full by week 13. No fees will be collected on week 14.
- Bowlers under the age of 21 may not advance to the Summer Challenge Tournament (see below). A team may select another bowler from this league, aged 21 or older, to replace the ineligible bowler.
- If there is a tie for 1st place after bowling is completed on week 14, there will be an immediate 1-game roll-off with the same bowlers using the same averages as the beginning of the night. In the case of a tie for 1st place after the roll-off, another 1-game roll-off will be held until a winner is determined. All other ties (2nd place on) will be determined by total pinfall (including handicap).

WHAT IS THE FVBPA SUMMER CHALLENGE TOURNAMENT?

The top half of the league will advance to the Summer Challenge Tournament, comprised of trio teams from 17 Fox Valley centers. First place is estimated to be \$4,500.00, with \$15,000.00 in total prize money available (based on 75 teams). Teams will bowl six games in Baker format with 95% of 225 handicap. One in 4 teams will cash for a minimum of \$300. The tournament will be held at the end of August at a Fox Valley center to be announced. There will be no additional fees required of qualifying bowlers. Bowlers under the age of 21 are not eligible for the Summer Challenge Tournament; however, a qualifying team may replace such a bowler with another bowler, age 21 or over, from the same league.
